

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licensee shall observe and perform all rules and regulations which the Warden and Fellows of St. Columba's College shall from time to time specify in relation to the use of St. Columba's Golf Course. In this regard, the College Bursar will represent the Warden and Fellows of the College, and issue all instructions on behalf of the Warden and Fellows.
- 2. The Licensee shall use the Course only at such periods and at such time or times as the Bursar shall from time to time specify, it being acknowledged that the requirements of the pupils and staff of the College in relation to the use of the course shall at all times have priority over the requirements of any other person using the course by permission of the Bursar.

Pupils will have priority on the course at the following times, during school term only:

- a. Summer Timetable (St. Valentine's Day to Halloween) 3.15pm to 4.15pm
- b. Winter Timetable (Halloween to St. Valentine's Day) 1.45pm to 2.45pm
- c. Each Wednesday and Saturday and other half holidays 1.45pm to 2.45pm

At the above times members of the College will have absolute priority on the tee, even if they are starting their second nine.

d. Sundays 11.00am to 12 noon and from 4.00pm to 5.00pm – Members of the College starting their second round will alternate with anyone else on the tee.

During School Holidays (about 17 weeks per year) there are no restrictions, but the College reserves the right to allow time for pupils attending Summer School to play some golf during their stay. Licence holders are expected to encourage members of the College to use their priority since students are unlikely to insist on their rights and their time on the course is very limited.

Any alterations to the above arrangements will be posted in the Club House in advance.

- 3. The use of the course by the Licensee shall be solely in the Licensee's personal capacity.
- 4. The facility having been granted by the College to the Licensee shall expire on 30th June and may be withdrawn or terminated at any time before that date if the College think it necessary or advisable for any reason so to do.

- 5. No liability whatsoever shall attach to the Fellows, Warden, staff or pupils of St. Columba's College for any injury sustained or loss or damage suffered by the Licensee in the course of or arising out of the use of the St. Columba's College Golf Course pursuant to the licence.
- 6. The Licensee indemnifies the Fellows, the Warden, the staff and pupils of St. Columba's College against all injury, loss or damage caused to them or to their property or any other person or property arising out of or in the course of the use of St. Columba's College Golf Course by the Licensee pursuant to the licence. The Licensee shall take out and at all times maintain adequate insurance against all such risks and shall produce the Policy of insurance and current premium receipt therefore for inspections by the Bursar or his Agent on demand.
- 7. The Licensee shall not do anything which may in any way interfere with or supplement the management, control or maintenance of the St. Columba's College Golf Course or the facilities thereof by the authorities of St. Columba's College, their servants or agents.
- 8. The Licensee shall at all times commence play from the 1st tee, and not at any other location on the Course.
- 9. Dress Code. The College expects that all players' clothes are neat and tidy and the following items of dress are unacceptable on the Golf Course:
 - Collarless shirts
 - Sports strips/shirts
 - Shirts worn outside trousers
 - Sweaters without shirts
 - 35 Garments with offensive logos
 - Untailored shorts
 - Track suits
 - Combat trousers
 - Denim jeans
 - Runners or trainers

Appropriate golf footwear is required on the golf course and practice green at all times. Any type of footwear worn on the course is not acceptable in the pavilion.

10. Etiquette.

- 35 All Licensees should display their valid Licence Tag at all times. Each Licensee and guest playing a round of golf must have their own bag and clubs.
- The use of mobile phones is prohibited on the course except in emergencies.
- Please ensure you are on time to start your round.
- Please be aware of slow play. If your group is holding up another, please let the faster group play through.
- Please replace divots on the fairways, repair pitch marks on the greens and rake the bunkers.
- Please be aware of other golfers on the course. Do not play your shot until the group ahead is out of range.
